The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, March 3, 2003 at 6:00 p.m. in the Commission Room at City Hall.

Candy Schmitt opened the meeting with prayer.

Motion by Commissioner Smith to approve the minutes of the February 18, 2003 regular meeting. Seconded by Commissioner Lentz. All aye.

Motion by Commissioner Lentz to approve appropriation ordinances #2705 (Payroll) in the amount of \$28,563.73 and #2706 (Disbursements) in the amount of \$42,765.47. Seconded by Commissioner Smith. All aye.

Purchase of Jack Hammer

Mr. Leighton requested that the City be allowed to purchase a used jackhammer for the new backhoe. The cost of the jackhammer is \$6500. It could be paid for from the electric generation project fund.

Motion by Commissioner Smith to purchase the jackhammer at a cost of \$6500. Seconded by Mayor Thomas. All aye.

City Administrator's Agenda

The cost of materials is \$9,997.98 from Kansas Electric Supply. Motion by Mayor Thomas to purchase the materials needed from Kansas Electric. Seconded by Commissioner Lentz. All aye.
