The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting on Monday, March 21, 2005 at 4:00 p.m. in the Commission Room at City Hall.

Present: Mayor White, Commissioners B. Stirton, K. Stirton, and Ken Krug. Staff present was Ron Smith, City Administrator.

The purpose of the meeting was to choose a successor to fill the unexpired term of Parks and Recreation Commissioner vacated by Tim Lentz due to his resignation.

The commission interviewed Kathy Madere, Shane Gigstad, and Steve Davies. After considerable discussion in open session as to the needs of the city and the strengths the various candidates could bring to the position, a motion was made by Mayor White to appoint Steve Davies as Parks and Recreation Commissioner. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Krug. The vote was Krug and White aye, B. Stirton and K. Stirton, nay. A tie vote in such a proceeding is made by the City Attorney, per the applicable statute. City Attorney Kevin Hill voted in favor of Davies. Davies was appointed on a 3-2 vote.

With no other business on the agenda, the special meeting adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
