The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting on Wednesday, June 14, 2006 at 5:30 p.m. in the Commission Room at City Hall to review information and approve an increase in the letter of credit for purchase of transmission and to discuss a request from Tom Williams to use the portable toilets at a mud run in Hiawatha on June 17.

Mayor White called the meeting to order.

Present: Commissioners Krug, B. Stirton, Davies and K. Stirton.

Absent: Mayor White.

Two cities have pulled out of the GRDA agreement. This makes it necessary for the City of Horton to supply a letter of credit for \$204,000 instead of \$75,000 for the purchase of power transmission for the years 2010 to 2026.

Motion by Commissioner Davies to approve to increase the letter of credit to \$204,000. Seconded by Commissioner K. Stirton. All aye.

The City received a request from Tom Williams to use the portable toilets on the trailer for a mud run in Hiawatha on June 17 & 18. Motion by Commissioner Davies to approve the request if the group is a non-profit, 501c3 organization. Seconded by Commissioner K. Stirton. They also stated that the City should have an agreement to be signed when the portable toilets are loaned out.

The meeting adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
